



### Introduction:

This is a guide to help you record the best possible footage on your respective devices and upload it to the F1 portal ready for the virtual fan platform. By default, smartphones are not set to record in the highest possible quality- this is to reduce the file size of the footage you record and to prevent heavy battery drainage.

# iPhone Video Settings



Navigate to Settings > Camera > Record Video, here you'll be presented with various video qualities- which ones that appear depend on your iPhone model. Ensure that "4K at 60 fps" is enabled. If no "4K" options are visable, then enable "1080p HD at 60 fps". We recomend adjusting your settings back to the default "1080p at 30 fps" once you're finished recording your video.

## Android Video Settings

Navigate to the Camera App > Settings > Video Size, ensure this is on the highest setting marked with "UHD" or "4K". We recomend adjusting your settings back to the default "1920x1080" once you're finished recording your video.



# You're ready to go!

Now that you're equipment ready, its time to get recording! To avoid cropping, ensure your device is landscape.
