

## RUGBY FOOTBALL UNION PROMOTIONAL COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The promoter of the competition is the Rugby Football Union, Rugby House, Twickenham Stadium, 200 Whitton Road, Twickenham, Middlesex, TW2 7BA (RFU, we).
2. The Competition is the 'RFU Injured Players Foundation (IPF) Survey' competition and is open to all individuals: (i) that have completed the 'RFU Injured Players Foundation (IPF) Survey'; (ii) that are a member of an Eligible Team (as defined below); and (iii) that submit an entry to the Competition on behalf of an Eligible Team between 13 April 2026 at 09:00 and 19 June 2026 at 23:59.
3. The Competition is open to rugby union teams meeting the following eligibility criteria (each an "**Eligible Team**"):
  - a. Any adult male rugby union team that is currently registered and takes part in the RFU England Rugby Men's Leagues at the level National One and below, including any RFU-approved men's merit league or table, as listed in the RFU Game Management System
  - b. Any adult female rugby union team that is currently registered and takes part in the RFU England Rugby Women's Leagues at National Challenge One, Two or Three or Inner Warrior Series, as listed in the RFU Game Management System
4. Entrants must be residents in the United Kingdom that are aged 18 and over and must not be employees or agents or suppliers of the RFU (including families of employees or agents or suppliers of the RFU or anyone directly connected with the competition).
5. In entering the Competition, you confirm that you are: (i) eligible to do so including on behalf of the applicable Eligible Team; and (ii) eligible to claim any prize you may win on behalf of the applicable Eligible Team. The RFU may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the Competition.
6. Submission of an entry into the Competition must be made by: (i) completing the 'RFU Injured Players Foundation (IPF) Survey'; and (ii) providing a valid email address to enter the Competition when prompted following completion of the 'RFU Injured Players Foundation (IPF) Survey' between 13 April 2026 at 09:00 (**Opening Date**) and 19 June 2026 at 23:59. (**Closing Date**).
7. Competition entries are limited to one per person.
8. By submitting a Competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.
9. Entry into the Competition is free. No purchase necessary.
10. The Competition will run from 13 April 2026 at 09:00 ("**Opening Date**") to 19 June 2026 at 23:59. ("**Closing Date**"). All competition entries received before the Opening Date or after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.
11. The Competition winner will be awarded as follows:
  - a. Every eligible entrant who has entered the Competition on behalf of an Eligible Team in accordance with these terms and conditions between the Opening Date and the Closing Date will be entered into a prize draw to win one (1) 2 (two) hour coaching session with an RFU Injured Players Foundation ("**IPF**") Ambassador at the winner's Eligible Team ("**Prize**").
12. The winner will be notified via email using the contact email address provided in the 'RFU Injured Players Foundation (IPF) Survey'.
13. The date of the Prize is subject to availability and will be organised in collaboration with the winner, with the final decision in respect of the date for delivery of the Prize to be determined by the RFU at its sole discretion.
14. The RFU will not accept:

- a. responsibility for Competition entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or
  - b. proof of transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the Competition.
15. The RFU accepts no responsibility for any costs associated with the Prize (including without limitation costs for delivery and returns, travel insurance, the cost of any transfers, food and drink, spending money, tax or personal expenses). Any other costs incurred in addition to those set out above and that are incidental to the fulfilment of the Prize are the responsibility of the winner.
16. The winner will be verified by an RFU or IPF employee and notified by email on or after 1 July 2026 using the contact details gained through the Competition entry form ("**Announcement Date**").
17. The RFU and/or the IPF will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or are not available or has not claimed their relevant Prize within 30 days of the Announcement Date, the RFU reserves the right to offer the relevant Prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the Closing Date.
18. There is no cash alternative available. The RFU reserves the right to replace, amend or vary the Prize provided by the RFU with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond the RFU's control makes it necessary to do so.
19. The RFU must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation the RFU will send the surname and county of the Prize winner and, if applicable copies of their winning entries, to anyone who emails [surveys@rfu.com](mailto:surveys@rfu.com) or writes to the address set out in clause 1 above (enclosing a self-addressed envelope) within one month after the Closing Date of the competition.
20. If you object to any or all of your surname, county and winning entry being published or made available, please contact the RFU at [surveys@rfu.com](mailto:surveys@rfu.com). In such circumstances, the RFU must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.
21. Insofar as is permitted by law, the RFU, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the Prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the RFU, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.
22. If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the RFU may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the competition.
23. The RFU may need to contact you and ask you to provide personal information as part of the submission process. Disclosure and processing of this information shall be subject to terms set out in the RFU's Privacy Notice. The RFU will keep your personal information secure and will only use it for the purposes specified in the RFU's Privacy Notice. All personal information held by the RFU will be held in accordance with the terms of applicable data protection laws.
24. The RFU reserves the right at any time and from time to time to: (i) void, cancel, suspend, amend, modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, this Competition with or without prior notice due to reasons outside their control and/or where it becomes necessary to do so; and (ii) amend or modify these terms and conditions at any time.

25. These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the nonexclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
